



Welcome to 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten!

- ★ The best thing we can do, as our children's first teachers, is to read aloud to them every day. This will give our children the tools they need to be ready to read in kindergarten. Sharing stories and songs, talking, writing, and playing with our children will not only be fun but will instill a lifelong love of learning, reading, and books!
- ★ Anyone can register for this multiyear program at the library, please see the children's services staff to pick up your packet. Children should be ages birth to 5 years.
- ★ Then read, read, read! If you read 1 book a day for 3 years... it's 1,095 books! 10 books a week for 2 years... 1,040 books! 3 books a day for 1 year... 1,095 books!
- ★ Color a circle for every book you've read on your reading record. It counts if anyone reads a book to your child... grandparents, caregivers, brothers & sisters, even your favorite librarian! Reading a favorite book over and over counts each time. Use our bookmarks for a fun way to keep track of library books you've read!
- ★ Technology counts... When you listen to an audiobook or read on an ereader, list it on your reading record. Don't forget you can visit our website to access Tumblebooks for 100s of reading choices.
- ★ Prizes will be awarded for the first 100 books and other important milestone totals. Just come to the library with your completed reading record and see the children's services staff for your prize and pick up the next packet.
