

# The 9th Thompson Community Art Show

## 2012 APPLICATION

**Application Deadline:  
February 15, 2012**

The Thompson Community Art Show will be on exhibit during April 2012 at the Thompson Library/Community Center. Citizens who live or work in Thompson are eligible to submit original visual artworks that they created.

*For 2012 the theme is "Weather."*

Your artwork can be realistic or abstract, in any media. Possible interpretations are depictions of weather, how weather affects the world and its inhabitants, or any wordplay on "weather" or weather terms. An accompanying artist statement should describe each artwork.

*Opening Reception Wednesday, April 4, 2012 6:30 p.m.*

### Eligibility:

- All who live or work in Thompson, Connecticut are eligible to submit up to **TWO (2)** visual artworks.
- Original visual artwork in all media, ready for hanging. (Please submit individual application forms for EACH artwork.) NOTE: Space is limited. Ideally we would like to show everyone's work, but the committee reserves the right to make final decisions based on size, media and appropriateness.
- Size Limits: 2-dimensional work, including frame: 1000 square inches maximum each  
3-dimensional work must fit in the lobby showcase: maximum depth 7", maximum height 18"
- Be sure your hanging apparatus is secure (wire must span the width and be 3" from the top edge). We recommend wood frames. (*Stretched canvasses need not be framed.*)

**What to submit by February 15: Do NOT send original artwork at this time.**

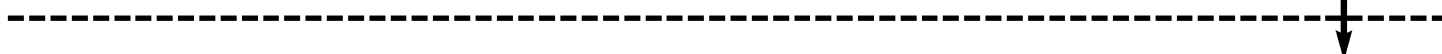
Send one complete **application form** for each of up to TWO artworks. Include your **artist statements**.

The committee will notify everyone of its decisions during the week of March 1, 2011 and will give final instructions then about when and where to deliver your artwork and how to prepare pieces for hanging. The show will be on display during April at the Thompson Library/Community Center, open during regular library hours. Pieces MUST be delivered and picked up during the assigned hours (to be announced) and must be available for the full month and may not be removed beforehand. All reasonable precautions will be taken but we are not responsible for loss or damage.

No sales will be transacted by the library or the committee. Prospective purchasers will be informed how to contact individual artists directly. (Please indicate below on the application if you DO NOT want your contact information given out.)
